**COFFEYVILLE RESOURCES ENGAGES GLOBALLY RECOGNIZED
REMEDICATION TEAM TO SUPPORT COMMUNITY RECOVERY EFFORTS**

COFFEYVILLE, Kan. (July 7, 2007) – Coffeyville Resources Refining & Marketing, LLC has hired a team of globally-recognized, EPA-certified experts – whose experience helped Gulf Coast refineries deal with the disastrous effects of Hurricane Katrina – to help manage the oil overflow recovery efforts in Coffeyville. The team is already on the ground and working in the community.

The team includes The O’Brien’s Group, who will manage the overall process, including containment and recovery. In addition, United States Environmental Services, LLC (USES) is providing the operations support, and the Center for Toxicology and Environmental Health (CTEH) will oversee sampling, analysis and reporting for the operation.

“We deeply care about the health and well being of the citizens of Coffeyville, as well as our own employees, many of whom live in this community,” said Chris Swanberg, Coffeyville Resources vice president of environmental, health and safety. “The companies we’ve hired are among the best in the world. They are directing the recovery operation occurring outside of our refinery.”

Meanwhile, Coffeyville Resources said more than 500 residents have already called the toll-free number established this week to help local residents file claims related to recent flooding and an oil overflow at its local refinery.

Call center operators collect property owners' information and then forward it to claims adjustors. The claims adjustors will contact the property owners to schedule an appointment as soon as possible. Operators also will be able to direct callers to local, state and federal disaster response agencies for additional assistance.
